

# **Elements Primary School**

Dear Parents,

I can hardly believe we are at the end of our first half term of the year.

As promised in last week's newsletter I can now give you the firm arrangements for our move into our new building.

Today representatives from McAvoys, the building contractor, the Department for Education and their technical advisers met with myself and other Trust personnel to discuss handover of the new build. The outcome of today's inspection is that the building is <u>not</u> yet ready to be handed over. There are outstanding works still not completed to a standard that would allow practical completion to be issued. Handover is however, fully expected next <u>Friday 1st November</u>.

Whilst this means our school will be ready for us to take possession it does not allow school any time to decant from the temporary buildings and set up the new build ready for children to attend.

I am sure you will feel as disappointed as we are, not to be moving into the new build on the 4th November as planned.

If we wait for the next school holiday to move in then it would mean we would remain in the temporary classrooms until Christmas. This is an option we have discussed but feel the implications for the children would be too great. Even simple activities like Christmas Nativities would not be possible and we feel that would be unfair.

As a solution and to ensure no further delay than necessary we will be implementing the following solution. Staff will work the weekend of 9th & 10th of November to physically move everything from school into the main build. School will be closed on Monday 11th & Tuesday 12th of November to allow for school to be unpacked and classrooms set up ready for children to begin in the new build on <a href="Wednesday 13th November">Wednesday 13th November</a>.

We appreciate that additional closure days cause inconvenience for parents and is very much our last choice of action. We feel that by following this plan it ensures that we are not affected by any further delay and we can give you, our families, a firm schedule of events.

As handover will have happened on the last day of half term we are hopeful we can use the first week back to complete some transition visits for our children and tours for our parents into our new school. It will obviously be an empty building but may well be a perfect introduction to such a huge new space for our children.

We are so grateful to you all for your understanding, ongoing patience and support this first half term. We are so close and hope that when we finally welcome you into our beautiful new school, you will feel the wait and disruption will all have been worth it.

Giving Consent


We have a number of trips happening in WOW week after half term.
