Dear Parents,

Here we are at the end of the first week already!

It has been a super first week in school and our children have done a fantastic job of settling into their new classes. They have also coped beautifully with being in our new building and having to stay within their 'bubbles'. We are very proud of them all.

Thank you to all those of you who have been so understanding of the restrictions we are duty bound to put in place to keep our school site safe. We appreciate that some procedures have taken more time and waits at the beginning and end of the day have been longer. Thank you for your patience. Please be assured that everything we are doing is in line with school guidance and is to keep everyone safe and our school open.

Please also be patient with staff if they remind you of our procedures. They are working very hard to keep themselves and the children safe. We all have a role to play in minimising the risks around the spread of COVID-19. This includes only one adult bringing the children to school and maintaining a 2 metre distance from others on site. No one wants a bubble or the school to close so we really must work together.

Build Update

As you will have seen when you have visited school the Phase 3 of the building works are still not completed. Whilst we are more than used to works on our build being delayed it does not take away the frustration of the site not being able to function as it should. As a Trust we are doing all we can to influence the completion on the works in as short a time as possible.

<u>Parking</u>

Whilst we do have some, albeit limited, parking on site I would ask please that you do not drive into the school site if you can avoid it. Cars are entering the site without due care and at too high a speed. Acre Mount has double yellow lines and yellow zig zag markings and therefore should not be used for parking either. These are there to minimise traffic around school and so I ask that you please adhere to them and park elsewhere. If you live within walking distance please do not drive to the school site at all. Please be considerate and do all you can to keep our children safe.

Changes to Reception Staff

I am sure many of the Reception parents will have noticed that Mrs Winstanley is expecting a baby. We are thrilled for Mrs Winstanley and her husband as they prepare for the birth of their third child. Mrs Winstanley will remain as Class teacher in Reception Class until she goes on maternity leave. Mrs Martin, our Assistant Principal will then move into Reception to take her place.

Flying Start Breakfast Club and Touchdown After School Club

In order to maintain school safety procedures the hall will be set up so children in different year groups do not mix. We are lucky to have a big space which allows us to keep our year groups safe within their 'bubbles'.

We also have the dance studio to use should it be necessary.

In order for us to safely run our before and after school provision we need to limit numbers to those who need it most. Therefore Breakfast and After School Club will only be open, for the time being, for children of working parents who have no other childcare arrangements.

Please enter Breakfast Club at the external hall doors. After School Club should collect from the same place.

Sun Protection

Next week there is some lovely sunny weather forecast. Please ensure your children are comfortable and protected from the sun by:

- 1. Ensuring they have a sun hat in school
- 2. Ensuring you have applied sun lotion at home
- 3. Remembering children can wear summer uniform i.e. yellow/green checked dresses or dark grey shorts

Please do not send sunglasses to school for your children to wear. There is an increased risk of injury if they fall. A sun hat with a brim or a peak is much better for shading their eyes.

Curriculum Clubs

Guidance permitting, we are hoping to open our Curriculum Clubs the week beginning 21st September.

We will be allocating places based on the responses we received to our questionnaire in July. Please be aware of the following:

- 1. Not all clubs will running straight away.
- 2. Clubs will have to be run as Year groups specific bubbles.
- 3. If your child does not get their first choice this time they will go to the top of the list for next term/half term
- 4. If a club is run by an outside provider the cost is £4 per session
- 5. You be notified of your child's club place by email next week.
