CHRISTMAS CARD LISTS

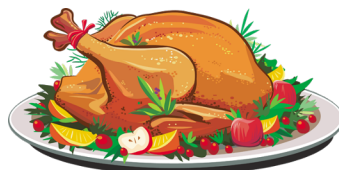
As requested we will be distributing class lists of children's names so everyone can send cards to their friends if they want to.
