Our New Build Update



Now our permanent build is due to start on site we will aim to update you on a weekly basis as our new school develops. We hope you will find it useful.

In the following days a letter will be going out to all residents near school from the build contractor. We will be sending out a copy of this letter to all our parents also. The following text is an extract from this letter which outlines what will be happening on site next.

The initial work will start with remediation of existing ground that has been present on the site for many years. This initial portion of works will take approximately 8 weeks.

The building structure is now being manufactured offsite at our factory in Northern Ireland to reduce the construction time. Cranage of this structure will begin April 2019 and should be concluded within two weeks. This will involve the delivery of large loads during that period. Deliveries have been carefully planned in close collaboration with the relevant authorities to minimise impact on residents and businesses.

The façade and roofing works will then be carried out, at the same time as the internal finishing, groundworks, paving and landscaping. Once the school has safely moved into the new buildings in Summer 2019, we shall then start the removal of the existing temporary school and landscaping to the southern area of the site. We aim to have the project fully handed over by Autumn 2019
