Our children's Christmas party days are listed on the right. Children can come dressed in their party clothes on the day of their party.

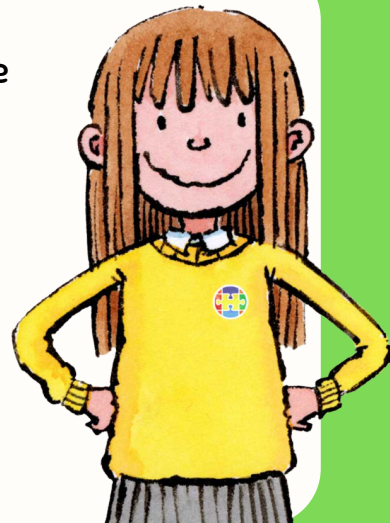
