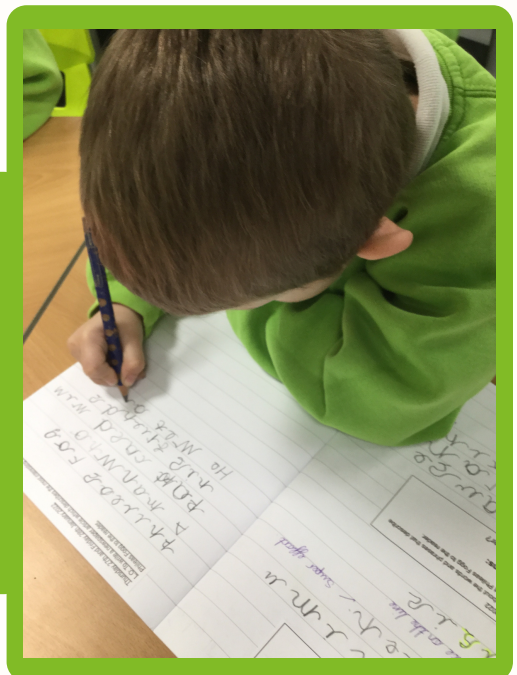


Reception – Diamonds

Year 1 – Dazzle

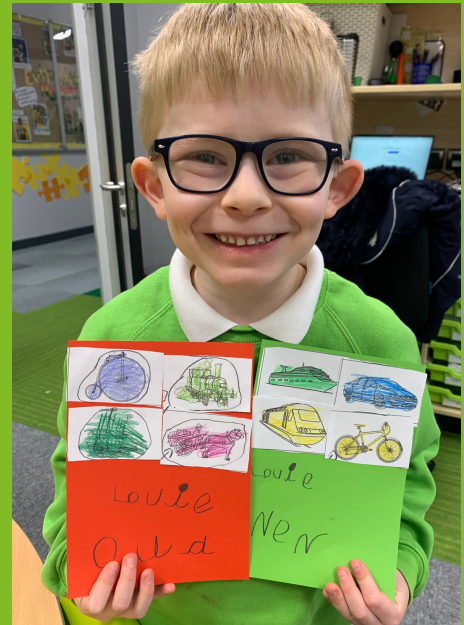

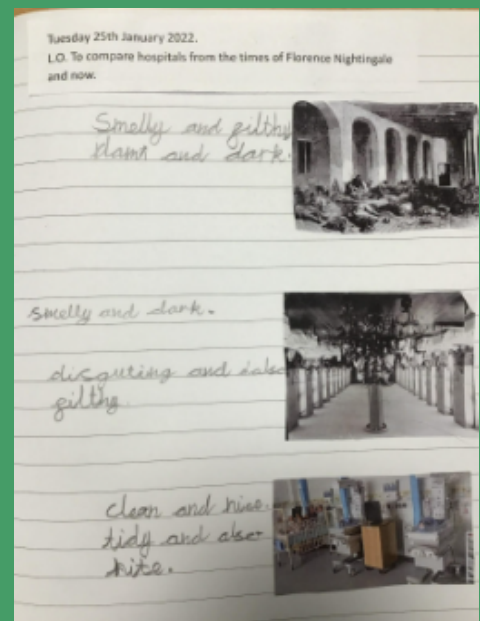


Year 2– Inspire

Year 2 – Discover

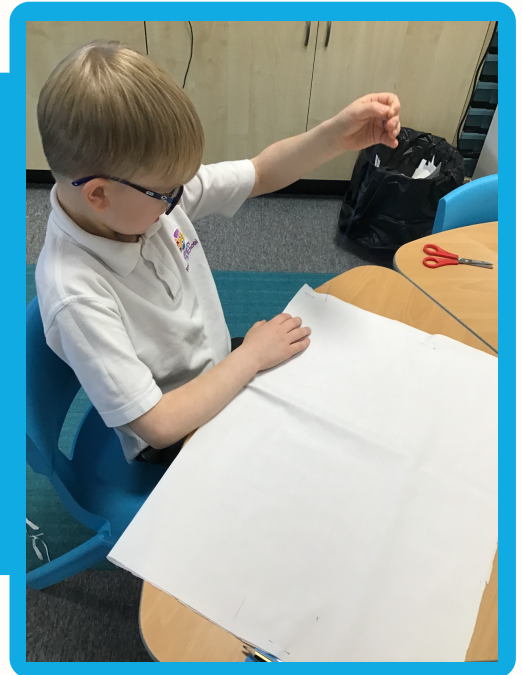
