I have already had the pleasure of visiting Elements and meeting the staff and children prior to starting in April and am looking forward to being part of the Elements community.





# Book Launch - Book Your Tickets!


Year 2 are very excited to invite their loved ones to their Book Launch!

### **Year 1 - Phonics**


#### Miss Turner - Dazzle

This week we have been exploring length and height in maths. We have loved measuring different objects in the classroom and comparing their lengths. There has been some fantastic concentration!




## Weekly Class Snapshot
